Gus Agustin's *Britannia* continues to work its way towards completion. In fact, the only primary piece left is the very ornate figure head. A remarkable example of the *Britannia* is on display at the Annapolis Naval Academy Museum. Gus is waiting for some reference material that will give him the information he needs to carve one.

This model now sports something that is relatively rare on Gus' models, canons! Although difficult to see, Agustin applied a grey wash to the guns, which emphasizes their details.

The lanterns on the right are only a fraction of the examples that Gus made before he was satisfied with a set that provided the correct scale and shape.

## The *No-Name* Battery Powered Airbrush by Toni Levine



While at the 2025 International Plastic Modelers Society (IPMS) National Convention, Toni Levine discovered this portable airbrush with cordless micro-compressor. Known as the "No-Name", the unit is battery powered, and can be recharged via USB.2 batteries. It allows you to adjust air pressure for full control over your painting.

The unit has an **auto on/off function**. You don't have to press the power button. Just use the airbrush as you would use any other double-action airbrush. Press the trigger down for air, and the cordless compressor will automatically start. Pull the trigger backwards, and paint flow will join the air. It comes with 2 batteries so one can be charging while you're using the second one for non-stop work. When fully charged, it will constantly run for **over 30 minutes**. It will deliver static pressure up to 32 PSI. When operating, it delivers **8-9 LPM** with a max pressure of **20-25 PSI**.

It has an LED indicator to show the charge level, which means a low battery won't surprise you. The compressor by itself weighs in at **7 ounces**. The compressor can be used for long periods without over-heating.


